Suíomh | Location

An Ghaeilge | Irish Language in the College

Lóistín | Accommodation

Fanann an chuid is mó de na scoláirí i dtithe nach bhfuil níos mó ná míle ón choláiste. Students stay with local families. The houses are inspected by Roinn na Gaeltachta during each course and accommodation and food are of a very high standard. Irish is the everyday language of each household.

Sláinte | Health

Bíonn dochtúir agus comhairleoir i gcónaí ar fáil i rith na gcúrsaí. In addition to dealing with minor ailments and problems such as homesickness and bullying, the counsellor makes sure the Coláiste and houses are kept clean. If an applicant has a health problem such as asthma, weak bones, eating disorders, diabetes etc. the college authorities must be informed. If special treatment or medication is required, the name and telephone number of the family doctor, along with a covering letter from the doctor must be provided. A form concerning health is sent to each student in May—it must be completed and handed in on the first day of the course. This information will be treated in confidence.

Taisteal | Travel

- Any student leaving the college before the end of the course will not be entitled to refund of fees.
- To avoid the misuse of mobile phones (especially those with cameras) and to protect fellow students, mobile phones must be handed in to the Bean an Tí. They will be made available to the students at a fixed time each day to allow them the opportunity to call home. (In the interests of child protection cameras are not permitted in the houses or in the college).
